


What are the 3 Theories?

Then 5,000 years ago our space daddies visited again and left us with a body of technology that launched the sudden development of major civilizations throughout the world like Egypt, Sumer and the Indus Valley people. Some of these evidence are found in the construction of megalithic structures made of gigantic, impossible to move stones, plus the *out of context*, technologically advanced artifacts, occasionally discovered in layers of earth that should not contain anything of any human origin.

Adam: Creationism - Begins with a belief that the book of Genesis outlines a literal historical record of our origins and early human history. This record begins with a God who speaks planets into existence instantly with just a word uttered. He took 7 days to create all life on planet Earth some 6,000 years ago, and the present condition of our planet we see today, is the aftermath of a world-wide catastrophic flood some 4,500 years ago.




The Days of Noah: The Flood - Part 1 (2019) 100 minutes in length.

Being able to demonstrate the forces of the world-wide flood of Noah and it's geological affect is a challenge, because no other event was as intense since that catastrophic episode. However the Mount St. Helens eruption of 1980 does give us a glimpse. In it you'll see evidence that Genesis is historically accurate with similar geological formations, like the grand canyon, forming in weeks, days or hours after this volcano's explosion.
